



DIY WOODEN COASTERS



FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

1. Using a 1" x 4" hardwood board, measure out 4" in length. Using the Bauer 4-1/2", 5.8 Amp Compact Circular Saw (Item 56164), cut the board.
2. Using your first cut piece of wood, measure the length of your next piece.
3. Make your cut.
4. Continue this process until you have your desired number of coasters.
5. Once you have all of your wood squares cut, sand each piece to be smooth using the Bauer 2.2 Amp 1/4 Sheet Palm Finishing Sander (Item 64146).
6. Wipe away any sawdust and finish with your desired stain or sealant.
7. Enjoy your new DIY Wooden Coasters!

MATERIALS:

1. (1) 1" x 4" Hardwood Board
2. Wood Stain
