

DIY WOODEN COASTERS





FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

- 1. Using a 1" x 4" hardwood board, measure out 4" in length. Using the Bauer 4-1/2", 5.8 Amp Compact Circular Saw (Item 56164), cut the board.
- 2. Using your first cut piece of wood, measure the length of your next piece.
- 3. Make your cut.
- 4. Continue this process until you have your desired number of coasters.
- Once you have all of your wood squares cut, sand each piece to be smooth using the Bauer 2.2 Amp 1/4 Sheet Palm Finishing Sander (Item 64146).
- 6. Wipe away any sawdust and finish with your desired stain or sealant.
- 7. Enjoy your new DIY Wooden Coasters!


- 1. (1) 1" x 4" Hardwood Board
- 2. Wood Stain
